

Noggin – 4 August 2022

Please find attached the notes of this month's Noggin which was held at the Bickerton Poacher.

- 20 members were at the meeting, with many Morgans in the car park.
- It was noted that the MSCC is working on a new IT policy relating to communicating with Centre Secretaries.
- Events over the next few months include:
 - North Cheshire Classic Car Show this weekend (7th). Places are still available if Members are interested. Access to the site is from 10 am, and food/breakfast will be available from stalls/farm shop. The public will start to arrive from 11 am. 200 visitors are expected at the event. A number of Stock Cars (from New Brighton) are expected. There has been a lot of interest shown from local car clubs. Food will be available during the event, but visitors can also bring their own picnic. Entertainment includes Ukulele band and a Viking re-enactment.
 - RAF Valley – 11 August. There were 27 expressions of interest in this event. Members were reminded that they must pre-book into the event. Email from John S dated 25 July has the details. A meeting point of the Co-op Car Park in Llanfair PG at 10 am was suggested.
 - Centre Picnic and Concours – 14 August. For catering purposes, requested that attendees let Gwyn and Jane know that they are attending. To cover all weather eventualities, Gwyn has arranged for a large marquee to be erected (same as last year). Pat and Richard will return the trophy at the weekend. Last minute attendees are all welcome.
 - 6 November (first Sunday of the month). Visit to Great British Car Journey. Expressions of interest to Kevin O, this is primarily for catering purposes at this point.
 - 9 October – no event has been planned for this date yet, so ideas to Joe please – something you want to organise, or for him to organise.
 - 11 December – Neil and June have identified a location (Vicars Cross Golf Club) for our Christmas meal and have an outline of the menu which looks comprehensive. They have an indicative cost, but this will be subject to review before it is finalized nearer the time.
- Joe discussed his recent purchase of upgraded wiper blades – and the fact that 2 x 7” blades and a (middle) 6” blade is the perfect combination for a clear screen on his 2008 Plus 4. He also promoted a Fire Safety Stick for the Morgan (as opposed to a fire extinguisher) as they are less bulky. The product was reviewed in Miscellany about two years ago, and a discount code can be found on the MSCC website. Jay Leno also promotes them on his You Tube Channel. Estimate of cost - small Fire Stick (25 seconds) £44.94, medium (50 seconds) £69.95.
