## **DEVAMOG EVENTS – 2023**

DevaMog's events programme for 2023 has been published and, as you will see, offers a wide range of activities which we hope will suit all pockets and interests. ## THE DANNY STEAMSHIP EXPERIENCE – Saturday 29 April 2023 @ 1pm

The first event is a cruise on the picturesque River Weaver on Saturday 29 April in a 1903 steam ship. As many of you will know, Graham and Lynne Jackson are members of the Daniel Adamson Preservation Society, which is a volunteer led charity behind the £5 million restoration project that has returned the 1903 steamship Daniel Adamson, or 'Danny' as she is affectionately known, back to operating service. Graham and Lynne are active volunteers with Graham often at the helm and Lynne helping out in the galley with on board catering.

Graham and Lynne have asked if DevaMog members would be interested in taking a cruise on the Danny in the Spring. One of the more popular trips is a 4 hour cruise on the River Weaver between the Sutton Weaver Swing Bridge, just outside Frodsham, and the Anderton Boat Lift. Our departure point is Sutton Weaver but we will park our cars at the Anderton Boat Lift and transfer to the Danny by coach. The Danny departs at 1pm and winds its way through some of the River Weaver's most stunning scenery taking in many historic sights. The Danny also passes through the Dutton Locks, which were constructed in 1880. Hopefully, Graham will be our skipper on the day. The cost of the cruise is £50 per person (depending upon numbers we may be able to negotiate a small discount). You can take your own food on board if you wish, or partake in refreshments purchased from the galley.

We would need to book in advance and pay a £5 non-refundable deposit per person with the balance due two weeks before the cruise. The second event is a guided walking tour around Port Sunlight Village which Stephen White has kindly offered to organise. This is an opportunity to discover the fascinating story of a village built on soap. Unlock the meaning behind the diverse architecture and hear the stories of village life past and present.



Stephen has provisionally booked the walking tour for 10.30am, that will take about 90 minutes, after which we can wander to our lunch venue between 12.30 and 1pm. There will be ample time after lunch to visit the many other attractions on site should you wish,

including the Port Sunlight Museum, the Soap Works Exhibition and the Lady Lever Art Gallery (entrance fees may apply).

Each tour guide can cope with up to 20 people and Stephen needs an idea of the number of members who would be interested in participating in the tour so he can book the required number of guides. The cost of the tour is £80 per 20 people so that equates to £4 per person. Depending on the final numbers and the number of guides required, this cost may vary slightly. Stephen is also organising an optional lunch and further details will be provided nearer the time.
