Information about the show

- The Classic Car Show at the Apedale Valley Light Railway (AVLR) has been running for many years.
- Last year we saw the biggest turn out with 130 vehicles attending and 15 stationary engines.
- For 2023, we are offering exhibitors the option of a gentle drive through the local countryside prior to exhibiting at the railway.
- People wishing to attend only the show can arrive from 9am.

Information about the run

- The run will start at 10am at the Shroppie Fly public house, Audlem Wharf, Shropshire St, Audlem CW3 0DX.
- The run is approximately 45 miles on A and B roads taking in the Shropshire, Staffordshire and Cheshire countryside.
- The run will end around midday at the AVLR where the cars will assemble on the event field with the rest of the vehicles already on show.
- Entry for the run is by a suggested donation of £10 per exhibit which includes a unique Rally Plaque (only available to those on the run), a Route Directions pack and two tickets for a train ride. Please consider signing the Gift Aid Certificate below.

EVENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The entrant must be the legal owner of the vehicle or be authorised by the owner to use the vehicle in the event.
- 2. Entries can only be accepted when this form has been completed in full and signed by the entrant. Please use a separate form for each vehicle.
- 3. No change of vehicle can be made without prior notification and acceptance of the organisers.
- 4. We as the authors of the route guidance for this Social Run reserve the right to alter the route and timing if circumstances beyond our control necessitate such action.
- 5. You confirm that the vehicle which you are using complies with the current Government requirements for use on the public highway, including but not limited to insurance, road fund licence and any applicable MOT.
- 6. You confirm that all drivers have a valid driving licence on the day of the Social Run.
- 7. You confirm that you understand that the scenic drive is a Social Run, defined as a non-competitive run for likeminded participants where there is no other purpose than the camaraderie of motoring in company to a predetermined point and which is not within the jurisdiction of Motorsport UK. You retain full responsibility for your vehicle and your driving in exactly the same way as you do in driving on any other day.
- 8. Our role as the Apedale Valley Light Railway has been to provide a suggested scenic route for this Social Run using public roads. We have no control over those roads, and we can provide no assurance as to safety or road conditions on the day of the drive as these are for you to ascertain. No guidance contained within our suggested route book should be taken as superseding the Highway Code or any other road traffic regulations, permanent or temporary, as the latter have primacy.
