Two Countries, Three Counties Scenic Run – Sunday 14 April 2024

Today's event is a scenic run from just outside Wrexham, taking in some beautiful countryside, and ending up at Sleaf Airfield, the home of the Shropshire Aero Club. The run has been organised by Ian Theobald – mobile 07901 670695.

We plan to meet at Commonwood Leisure Ground from 10.30am where you will find ample parking, a café and toilets. After taking refreshments, we intend leaving Commonwood around 11.15am to make our way south, driving on a mix of rural lanes and main roads. We will cross from Wales into England and pass through three counties, before ending our run at Sleaf Airfield for refreshments and the opportunity to view general aviation in action. We are hoping that the onsite WWII museum will be open during our visit.

Sleaf (pronounced Slape) is an ex-Royal Airforce airfield, opened in 1943, and used by the RAF for advanced flying training for crews that flew Whitley bombers. It's been the home of the Shropshire Aero Club since 1955.

There is no need to register for this event but if you are definitely planning on joining us, please let Joe Cleary know on joe.holthome@btinternet.com so we have a rough idea of the number of cars to expect. However, please don't be put off if you can't commit in advance, just turn up on the day.


Two Countries, Three Counties
