
## **DEVAMOG VISIT TO WROXETER ROMAN CITY**

On **Sunday 11 June 2023** we have organised a guided tour of Wroxeter Roman City, formally known as Viroconium Cornoviorum, which is located about 5 miles east of Shrewsbury. At its peak, Viroconium is estimated to have been the 4<sup>th</sup> largest Roman settlement in Britain, with a population of more than 15,000.



To ensure groups get the best experience with the guide, the tour is limited to 20 people. We will start our tour at 11am, which will take approximately 1 hour. If we have 11 or more participants in our group we are eligible for a group discount which means each adult will pay £11.81 or £11.04 if you are over 65. If you are a member of English Heritage you only pay £4.50 to cover the cost of the guide.

Our guide will take us through the remains of the bathhouse, where the townsfolk met to wash, exercise and socialise. We will examine the iconic 'Old Work', which is a 7 metre high basilica wall and is the largest piece of free-standing Roman wall in the country. We will explore a reconstructed town house from a city which was almost as large as Pompeii. The house was created in 2010 as part of a project with Channel 4. It is based on the design of a town house which once stood on the site at Wroxeter, and is complete with dining room, bath-suit and replica Roman furniture. We will also discover the daily lives of the people who lived here, made up mainly of foot soldiers, and visit the museum to see artefacts discovered at the site. You will then have free time to explore the site on your own.
